

The American Dance Magazine has named five people as recipients of its annual awards: flamenco artist Soledad Barrio; American Ballet Theatre principal

ballerina and current artistic director of National Ballet of Canada Karen Kain; dance archivist, writer and historian David Vaughan; and founding artistic director of Urban Bush Women Jawole Willa Jo Zollar. The awards will be presented by Mikhail Baryshnikov, Millicent Johnnie, Julie Kent, Martín Santangelo and Valda Setterfield at the Ailey Citigroup Theater in Manhattan on 7 December. Renowned dancer, artistic director, choreographer and teacher John Meehan will chair the jury for the 11th USA International Ballet Competition set for June 2018 in Jackson, Mississippi. Dutch National Ballet dancer Michaela DePrince gave a performance at the Women in the World Summit at Cadogan Hall in New York in October. A war orphan from Sierra Leone, DePrince was adopted by an American couple. In the USA, she studied at The Rock School for Dance Education in Philadelphia, and participated in the Youth America Grand Prix, where she won a scholarship to study at ABT's Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis School in New York. She danced with

Dance Theatre of Harlem before joining the Dutch National Ballet's Junior Company in 2013. She was invited to join the main company by artistic director Ted Brandsen the following year. Her book, Taking Flight: From War Orphan to Star Ballerina, is to be made into a film by MGM.
