

IRVINE BARCLAY THEATRE CLIENT PROTOCOLS

Beginning September 1, 2021 proof of fully vaccinated status will be required from all audience members twelve and older to gain entrance to the venue. Children ages 3 to 11 (inclusive), will be allowed to enter with masks as no vaccine is currently available for this age group. Additionally, masks will be required at all times inside the building for both children and adults.

This same policy applies to all rental clients, artists and production teams, and Barclay staff.

The following acceptable forms of vaccination proof are:

- Original vaccination card
- Photocopy of the original card
- Digital photo on device
- CA issued QRC

Additionally for anyone wanting an exemption to these protocols, they will need to show proof of negative COVID test within 48 hours of the date(s) in the theatre and must provide a completed copy of the COVID-19 Vaccination Reasonable Exemption Accommodation Form. Your organization will be responsible for collecting and certifying to the Barclay that all of your individuals who will be entering the building have provided proof of vaccination. If any individual(s) apply for exemption, your organization must certify that all completed COVID-19 Vaccination Reasonable Exemption Accommodation forms and a negative Covid test result (within 48 hours prior to first date entering the building) have been reviewed prior to the individual(s) entry into the building.

While masks are required at all times inside the building, artists/performers may remove their masks once they are on stage or in the pit. As soon as they exit the stage or pit they must wear their masks.
