YGP is thrilled to be partnering with the 2023 Nervi Festival to present its signature “Stars of Today Meet the Stars of Tomorrow” Gala in Genova, Italy, this July. The Nervi Festival, one of the most prestigious and significant events of the Italian dance scene, has welcomed some of the most celebrated artists of all time throughout its history, including Margot Fonteyn, Mikhail Baryshnikov, Rudolf Nureyev, and beloved Italian prima ballerina Carla Fracci.

Along with two evenings of the critically-acclaimed YGP Gala in collaboration with the Nervi Music Ballet Festival 2023, participants will also be invited to participate in 7 days of Master Classes with world renowned teachers from around the world.

The daily schedule of events will include free classes in both classical technique, character, contemporary repertoire, Broadway, body conditioning, and much more. Classes will be held in the Carlo Felice Theater, in the heart of Genova. The days of the performance, dancers will have classical technique class in the morning and Grand Defile rehearsal before the performances in the evening.

All dancers will also be a part of the YAGP Gala centerpiece the “Grand Defile” and invited to perform in both Galas!

The application fee is €850, this covers all 6 days of classes, participation in the Grand Defile rehearsals and performances, and tickets for the students to see the Galas (seating immediately following the Grand Defile).
