1. Health Code

• The health and safety of our participants remains our top priority, and YAGP will continue to follow all guidelines issued by the U.S. government, state and local/city governments, and theater policies.

2. General Information

- YAGP 2024 is open to dance students of all nationalities, ages 9-20 years old. Students younger or older may participate in the Ensemble or Pas de Deux category, as long as the average age of the dancers in the ensemble or Pas de Deux falls between ages 9 and 20 years old.
- A participant's age for the entire YAGP 2024 season is determined strictly as of January 1, 2024.
- Professional dancers are not permitted to compete in YAGP.
 - A professional dancer is defined by YAGP as anyone who is employed as a fulltime dancer (Apprentices included) with a professional dance company on a yearly contract that engages the dancer at least 26 weeks per year. This includes dancers who are not currently employed under such a contract, but have been in the past.
- We encourage YAGP participants, parents, and teachers to check the YAGP website http://www.yagp.org and to follow YAGP on all social media platforms (Facebook, Instagram, and YouTube) for the latest news, live-streaming of YAGP events, registration information and other updates.
- Participants may enter the competition as soloists, part of an ensemble, or in a Pas De Deux entry, or in any combination thereof.
- Participants are welcome to register at multiple Semi-Final locations (subject to space availability at each location).
- In order to compete in the Classical Ballet category at any regional Semi-Final, dancers must select their variation from the <u>Classical Repertoire List</u> for their age group.
- It is the participant's responsibility to obtain approval to present choreography for any variations that require approval specified at the end of the <u>Classical Repertoire List</u>.
- Students are able to perform more than one variation, however, YAGP reserves the right to restrict the number of variations a student may perform, restrict the number of events a student attends, or decline any registration at YAGP's discretion (based on available space).
- All solo participants have a choice of performing in one or both of the following categories:
 - Classical Ballet: Variation must be chosen from the <u>Classical Repertoire List</u>.
 - Contemporary/Open Dance: This category includes any "open solo" variation that is not taken from the Classical Repertoire List and features a different aspect of the participant's skill and versatility as a dancer. Music in this category is not limited to only instrumental tracks and may contain appropriate lyrics.

- In order to qualify for Finals, each Junior and Senior participant must perform at least one Classical variation from the repertoire list, provided by YAGP. For Pre-Competitive participants, dancers may qualify for Finals either in Classical Ballet or Contemporary Dance category or in both.
 - Once invited to the Finals, all Junior and Senior participants must perform one Classical variation and one Contemporary solo.
- Participants who wish to perform a Pas de Deux from the Classical Repertoire List may perform Adagio and Coda only.
- Pre-Competitive participants are restricted to the Pre-Competitive specific Classical Repertoire List. YAGP rules allow for Pre-Competitive participants' teachers to make slight changes to the original, classical choreography, in order to accommodate a student's specific technical level.

3. Age Divisions

- Senior Age Division: 15 20 years old (born between January 2, 2004 and January 1, 2009)
- Junior Age Division: 12 14 years old (born between January 2, 2009 and January 1, 2012)
- **Pre-Competitive Age Division**: 9-11 years old (born between January 2, 2012 and January 1, 2015)

• Ensemble Age Division:

- The average age for an ensemble must be between 9 and 20 years old.
- Professional dancers cannot participate as partner (Professional dancer: any dancer who is apprentice, trainee, part time or full time dancer with a professional dance company)
- For Pas de Deux entries where the male dancer is 14 years old or younger, it is strongly encouraged that the piece be performed using "par terre" partnering only, with no lifting above the shoulder level.

4. <u>Registration Process</u>

- Participants must register online on the YAGP website <u>http://www.yagp.org</u>
- To properly complete registration or open a new account, we strongly suggest watching the video/s with the step-by-step instructions **before** registering or creating any new account: <u>https://yagp.org/registration-tutorials/</u>
- Participants may enter the competition either as an Individual Dancer or a Dancer representing the school.
 - You must set up an Individual account and obtain your school's 36-digits studio code <u>before</u> registration can be started), or the Studio/School may register all participants for YAGP. All Ensembles <u>must</u> be registered through a Schools/Studios account.
- If your school has already created an account, school representatives should follow the same process this season and register all the students. Once the registration has been completed, students may login to the school account, using their login information created and sent by the Dance Genie Registration System to their email address. Students or their guardian must verify the information that has been inputted by the school representative and make a partial or full payment.
- For both new and existing Individual accounts, in order to be properly registered under a school, participants **must** obtain the 36-digit school ID number from the school's representative. Failure to use the 36-digit school ID number may result in not being able to link the individual dancer's registration to their school.
 - **IMPORTANT:** If the 36-digit school ID number is not used **<u>BEFORE</u>** your initial registration, it will NOT be possible to link an Individual account to a school's account later.
 - This 36-digit studio code is only available on the school's dashboard and must be provided by the school's representative. YAGP will <u>not</u> be able to provide this 36-digit code nor link accounts.
- If you are registering through multiple accounts (for example: both an Individual account for your solos and a School account for ensembles), it will be the Participant's responsibility to notify YAGP of the multiple registration fees **<u>before</u>** making the second payment. YAGP is not liable for registration fees paid twice. No refunds will be provided.
- In order to proceed to the payment section, participants <u>must</u> have a completed waiver on file. For more information on how to complete the waiver, please follow the linked tutorial <u>https://yagp.org/registration-tutorials/</u>
- YAGP is not responsible for the information entered by the participants or their representatives in the online registration system. It is the participant or school's responsibility to review the information they enter and make sure it is correct.
- After completing the registration, including payment in full, you are able to login back to your account and refer to your account Dashboard and double check all details that have been entered. Please use this tutorial how to confirm your registration- https://yagp.org/registration-tutorials/

5. Semi-Final Fees

YAGP fees are determined by the time frame in which all fees are paid in full.

• <u>REGULAR FEES: Full Registration/Payment AFTER September 1, 2023:</u> (*For Fall Venues AFTER August 1, 2023*)

- Registration/Administrative Fee: **\$120** (*this is a non-refundable fee that ensures the participants' place in the competition and includes complementary master classes offered at each YAGP Semi-Final*)
- Classical or Contemporary Solo: **\$125** for each solo entry
- Classical Pas de Deux \$120 per dancer, per entry
- Contemporary Pas de Deux **\$85** per dancer, per entry
- Duet/Trio **\$80** per dancer, per entry
- Small Ensemble (4 dancers) **\$65** per dancer, per entry
- Large Ensembles (5+ members) **\$55** per dancer, per entry

• <u>LATE REGISTRATION: Full Registration/Payment 45 DAYS Prior to Competition:</u> (*For Fall Venues 30 DAYS Prior to Competition*)

**\$10 late fee applied to each solo entry, \$5 late fee applied to all ensemble entries

- Registration/Administrative Fee: **\$120** (*this is a non-refundable fee that ensures the participants' place in the competition and includes complementary master classes offered at each YAGP Semi-Final*)
- Classical or Contemporary Solo: \$135 for each solo entry
- Classical Pas de Deux \$125 per dancer, per entry
- Contemporary Pas de Deux **\$90** per dancer, per entry
- Duet/Trio **\$85** per dancer, per entry
- Small Ensemble (4 dancers) **\$70** per dancer, per entry
- Large Ensembles (5+ members) **\$60** per dancer, per entry
- In order to reserve space at any location, YAGP must receive the registration/administrative fee deposit of \$120 per dancer, per location.
 - Attention: \$120 Registration/Administrative fee is non-refundable, nontransferable and non-creditable. Please refer to our no-refund policy below.

<u>Finals Fees</u> (Semi-Final fees cannot be transferred or applied to Finals payment)

Please note that entry fees for the Finals are **flat fees** that include the registration processing fee, all master classes, special events, and complimentary admission to all YAGP Finals activities including the Final Round and Gala.

- Soloist Junior and Senior: **\$360** per dancer
- Soloist Pre-Competitive: **\$325** per dancer
- Junior and Senior Pas de Deux (Classical and Contemporary): \$340 per dancer
- Pre-Competitive Pas De Deux (Classical and Contemporary): **\$340** per dancer
- Ensemble: **\$220** per dancer

Additional Fees (per dancer, per additional ensemble entry):

- Pas de Deux: **\$110**
- Duet/Trio: **\$60**
- Small Ensemble (4 dancers): **\$55**
- Ensemble (5 or more dancers): **\$45**
- Payment by check for both Semi-Final and Final Fees is strongly discouraged.

6. <u>Deadlines</u>

- When applying for Regional Semi-Finals, registrations are processed on a first come, first served basis.
- Registration will close when a venue has reached its maximum capacity. If you are still interested in registering for a venue that has reached capacity, you may register for the Wait List location the school/participant is interested in. No payment will be required or accepted. YAGP will do their best to accommodate all participants.
- All updates, including TBD entries, MUST be received no later than **2 weeks** before the competition weekend. Penalties will be applied. For more information, please refer to the <u>Penalties and Refunds</u> section below.
- The deadline for music submission is **2 weeks** prior to the first day of the competition. Penalties will be applied. For more information, please refer to the <u>Penalties and Refunds</u> section below.
 - Please <u>DO NOT</u> submit updated music less than **5 days** before the venue or it will not be accepted.
- If a \$0 payment has been made to your account 60 days prior to the competition (30 days for Fall Venues), YAGP reserves the right to completely remove your registration.

7. Penalties and Refunds

• Music Deadline (2 weeks before the first day of competition)

- Music submitted less than 2 weeks before the first day of the competition will acquire a **\$10** penalty fee per entry will be added to your invoice.
- Music submitted or updated during the competition weekend will acquire a **\$20** penalty fee per entry (payable onsite at the Registration table).

• TBD Deadline (2 weeks before the first day of competition)

- Entries listed as TBD (entry name To Be Determined) less than 2 weeks before the first day of competition will acquire a **\$10** penalty fee per TBD entry will be added to your invoice.
- The registration system will close for editing and corrections after the 2 week deadline.

• YAGP enforces a NO REFUND policy

YAGP fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

- **Credit(s)** only applicable to the **INJURED participants**, with a deduction of the **<u>\$120.00</u>** processing registration/administrative fee (per dancer, per location) and must be used before March 1, 2024.
 - Credit(s) (only of the entry fee(s)) issued only in the event of a physical injury. All requests for a credit must be accompanied by an official letter from a specialist doctor (family doctor's letter will not be sufficient and will not be accepted). The letter must be on the office letterhead and include an ink signature, doctor's stamp. and must be sent directly to <u>finance@yagp.org</u> no later than 2 weeks prior to the competition's first date. If YAGP will not be notified 2 weeks prior to the competition's first date, only 50% of the entry fees will be provided as a credit, with an exception of force majeure or emergency situations.
- Dancers that are not physically injured, but unable to attend due to **ILLNESS**, entry fees (with a deduction of the \$120.00 registration/administrative fee) can be transferred to another convenient location based on availability. Doctor's note must be provided. Credit must be used before March 1, 2024.
 - Doctor's letters must be on the office letterhead and include an ink signature, doctor's stamp. and must be sent directly to <u>finance@yagp.org</u> no later than 2 weeks prior to the competition's first date. If YAGP will not be notified 2 weeks prior to the competition's first date, only 50% of the entry fees will be provided as a credit.
- \$120 Registration/Administrative Fees (per dancer, per location) are non-creditable, non-refundable and non-transferrable for any reason whatsoever.
- Please note that if you are registering through multiple accounts (Example: Both an Individual account for your solos and a School account for ensembles) it is your responsibility to notify YAGP of the multiple registration fees BEFORE making the second payment. YAGP is not liable for registration fees paid twice.

FINANCIAL AID

We are committed to providing performance and training opportunities to young dancers. If you wish to participate in YAGP but are experiencing financial hardship, please send an official letter request to the Financial office at <u>finance@yagp.org</u> for assistance. Financial Aid is only for one venue per season.

8. Teacher Badges

- Independent participants and schools with up to 3 students, **1 Teacher Badge** will be distributed at the Welcome Table upon arrival at the event to those who have completed the Teacher Badge Google Form, prior to the deadline.
- Schools with 4 or more students, **2 Teacher Badges** will be distributed at the Welcome Table upon arrival at the event to those who have completed the Teacher Badge Google Form, prior to the deadline.
- **Important:** Prior to your regional semi-final competition, please ensure that you have completed the **Teacher Badge Google Form** for your event, which will be emailed to the registration email in advance. Badges will only be granted to the teacher(s) specified in the form, regardless of the names entered in the "Teacher" field of your registration. Email requests for badges will not be accepted.
- A Teacher Badge is a complimentary pass to attend Open Stage with his or her dancer(s) and may be picked up at the Welcome Table. The person listed for the respective badge will only be able to obtain this badge by showing a valid ID.
- Please note that teachers are NOT to be backstage or in the dressing rooms areas unnecessarily if crowding occurs, the theater will ask everyone to exit these areas.
- Parents will not be permitted backstage or in the dressing room areas. If the dancer is of Pre-Competitive age and participating without his or her teacher in attendance, please visit the Welcome Table for alternative assistance.

9. Music Submission

- It is strongly recommended that dancers select their Classical Variation music from the YAGP Classical Music Library (www.yagp.org). This resource was compiled for the convenience of our participants and teachers to have access to high-quality recordings that meet current music copyright regulations required for live streaming.
 - Please note that in many cases, there are multiple versions available for each variation. Tracks may be adjusted for tempo changes or cut as needed.
- Dancers who choose to use classical variation music that is *not* from the library, or if the particular variation is not available in the library at this time, the dancer's video may be muted online in the event of any copyright issues with the track. Tracks will <u>not</u> be muted onstage during their actual performance in the theater.

To upload your music, please follow the below instructions:

- Please login into your Dance Genie Account, on your Dashboard click on "Upload Music" button. (You will follow these same instructions to update/replace music, as well).
- All files <u>MUST</u> be in .mp3 or .m4a format
- Please make sure to name your music file(s) as follows:
 - Solo Entries: "Last Name First Name AGE Name of the Dance"
 - Pas De Deux / Ensemble Entries (if any): "Name of the Dance PDD or Ens or Duet or Trio - School Name - lengths of the music"
- In order to confirm your music has been uploaded, please repeat step 1 to see the file.
- If the classical variation you have selected is not in the music library, please upload your own file.

**Please be advised that any music by Kerry Muzzey is strictly forbidden at all YAGP events due to music copyright regulations.

10. Time Limits

- Classical Variation or Contemporary/Open Solo: Maximum 2:30
 - Paquita Wedding variation can be up to 2:42
- Ensembles:
 - Classical Pas de Deux: Maximum 6:00 (Adagio and Coda only)
 - Contemporary Pas de Deux: Maximum 3:30
 - Duet/Trio (2-3 members): Maximum 2:45
 - Ensemble (4 members): Maximum 3:30
 - Ensemble (5+ members): Maximum 5:00

**Participants are NOT permitted to purchase additional time. Any entry with music that exceeds the allotted time limit may result in point deduction or disqualification.

11. <u>Performing En Pointe</u>

- We are strongly committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all dancers, and especially of our youngest participants. Please make sure that you adhere to the guidelines set forth below.
- Students Age 10 and under are strictly prohibited from performing en pointe. If participants still choose to perform en pointe, they will not be eligible for any Top 3 placement at that venue.
- Students Age 11 are strongly discouraged from performing en pointe.
- Pre-Competitive students performing en demi-pointe may perform any variation from the Junior list of repertoire in addition to the Pre-Competitive repertoire list.

12. Master Classes

- Master Classes with YAGP jury members and master teachers are an integral part of the YAGP experience and part of YAGP's educational mission. Though **participation is not mandatory**, we strongly encourage all participants to take advantage of this valuable part of the YAGP experience.
- Not attending the Master Classes will not affect a participant's score or standing with YAGP.

13. Livestream

• YAGP reserves the right to make photo and/or video recordings at any time during any YAGP event. This includes, but is not limited to, the recordings of master classes, participants' rehearsals or performances during the competition, or any activities in the venue lobby or backstage. By participating in YAGP, participants and their parents and/or legal guardians give their express permission for YAGP to make any photo/video recordings at any time. Also, by participating in YAGP, participants and their parents or legal guardians give YAGP their express permission to use any such photo/video recordings (including those containing their name or likeness) for YAGP promotional purposes (including any uses in print, online, or in social media).

14. Virtual Competition

• In the event that it is necessary to conduct any YAGP 2024 events virtually for the health and safety of our participants, dancers will be notified by email -- and information will be posted on the YAGP website and announced on social media

15. <u>Classical Repertoire List</u>

- To participate in YAGP's Classical Ballet category, participants are strongly encouraged to select a variation from the Classical Repertoire List below. This list is approved by the majority of the YAGP Jury Panel. If you choose to perform a variation that is not on the list below, please be aware that it will be at the discretion of each judge to determine if it is age and skill appropriate for the dancer.
 - Participants who pass to the YAGP Season Finals with a variation that is not from the approved Classical Repertoire List, the Jury Panel may request that the dancer change their current variation to one from the approved list for the Finals.
- Any work not listed in the Classical Repertoire list should be registered as a Contemporary/Open category entry.

16. <u>Props</u>

- YAGP reminds teachers, parents, and students that backstage space is often limited. We ask choreographers to respect this circumstance when making their pieces and limit the use of props to the absolute minimum. Theaters may also restrict the use of props at their discretion.
- All props that participants wish to use are used at the participants' own risk. YAGP is not responsible for any injury or incident resulting from a participants' use of props of their choice.
- YAGP does not provide storage for any props.
- YAGP does not provide assistance with the movement of props either on or off stage. Both the storage and the movement of props on and off stage are the responsibility of the participant.
- YAGP is not responsible for any lost props.
- All props must be approved no later than 3 weeks before the first competition day. To approve the usage of props at the YAGP Finals, please add this in the 'Notes' section of your registration
- YAGP does not provide assistance with any shipping of props before or after a competition.

17. Regional Awards and Scoring

- The scoring system consists of two elements artistic and technical and is evaluated on a 100- point system. Each judge's scores are the average of the technical and artistic marks. The total score is the average of scores given by all judges (there are usually three to five judges at each regional Semi-Final), all from different backgrounds. In addition to providing a numerical score for each participant's performance, judges may offer personal comments on the score sheet to help guide participants in their training.
- All scoring results will be done electronically and will be sent shortly after the event to the registration email address
- Awards Ceremonies will be held <u>live</u>, unless restricted by local travel or health regulations. In that case, it will be conducted online, and the date and time will be announced for each location via email.
- YAGP Rules and Regulations do not permit participants to receive winning placement at more than one location. The only exception to this rule is when a dancer places higher than in the previous venue.
 - Example: If a dancer has already placed in the Top 12 at one Regional Semi-Final, he/she will not be eligible to be placed in Top 12 at any other location unless they place higher (1st, 2nd or 3rd place).
- Categories may be announced either separately or combined. This will be determined at the judges' discretion.
 - If less than 6 male soloists are competing in the same age category, YAGP will combine male and female soloists in the age category.
 - Small and Large ensembles will be either combined or separated at the discretion of the judges.
 - If less than 6 Classical and Contemporary Pas De Deux are competing, they will be combined in the ensemble category.

- **NEW!** Ensembles can be separated by 2 age categories (Junior and Senior) at the judges' discretion.
 - Junior Ensembles: average age up to 13 years old
 - Senior Ensembles: average age 14 and up
- Dancers who, by the consensus of the YAGP jury panel, have exceeded all other dancers in their age division in both the Classical Ballet and Contemporary/Open Dance categories may be awarded the Hope, Youth Grand Prix, or Grand Prix Award. To be considered for these top awards, participants must perform both a Classical Variation and a Contemporary/Open Solo.
 - The Grand Prix Award is given for the best overall performance in the Senior age division.
 - The Youth Grand Prix Award is given for the best overall performance in the Junior age division.
 - The Hope Award is given for the best overall performance in the Pre-Competitive Age division.
- The YAGP jury reserves the right not to present all of the announced awards.
- Participants who receive scholarship offers or letters of interest/acceptance following their regional semi-final should follow up directly with the contact information provided from the presenting school

18. Selection for the YAGP Finals

- To be eligible to participate in the Finals, dancers must be selected at one of the YAGP Semi-Final events (competitions, auditions or workshops)
- Dancers must receive a total score of 96 or higher for a solo entry in the Classical Ballet category*. Additionally, at the judges' discretion, individual solo participants who did not receive a total score of 96 or higher on their Classical Ballet variation may be invited to the Finals.
- Receiving a total score of 96 or higher in the Contemporary/Open category does not guarantee a participant's eligibility to be selected for the Finals.
- If selected for the Finals, in order to participate, Junior and Senior dancers MUST register with 1 classical variation and 1 contemporary solo.
- It is strongly suggested that participants register for the Finals with the same variation as the one on the basis of which they were selected for the Finals. However, it is not mandatory; participants may select any other variation from the Classical Repertoire List.
- Receiving 1st, 2nd or 3rd place at a regional Semi-Final does not guarantee selection for the Finals, as these places are awarded relative to the other performances in each category.
- Dancers that do not receive a score of 96 or higher, may still be eligible to pass to Finals by judges recommendation
- **Pre-Competitive** age division participants are eligible for the Finals if they receive a total score of 96 or higher for any of their solo performances.
 - Only the pieces that received a total score of 96 or higher are eligible for entry in the Finals. If a Pre-Competitive participant receives a passing score for several solo pieces, they may select a MAXIMUM OF TWO PIECES for the Finals – 1 Classical and 1 Contemporary.
- Ensemble entries are invited to the Finals at the judges' discretion or if received a total score of 96.
